**SB 22** This legislation places certain substances on the controlled substances schedule and to declare an emergency.

**Latest Action:** Signed by the Governor, 2/19/2019

**SDPhA Position:** Monitoring

**SB 62** This legislation provides for the use of certain general funds to increase Medicaid reimbursement rates for existing Medicaid providers.

**Latest Action:** Senate, Failed 1/30/2019

**SDPhA Position:** Monitoring

**SB 84** This legislation authorizes the possession and administration of opioid antagonists by school district and nonpublic school personnel.

**Latest Action:** Deferred to another day, House of Representatives 2/21/2019

**SDPhA Position:** Monitoring

**SB 136** This legislation provides for the utilization of telehealth by a health care professional.

**Latest Action:** Passed as amended, Senate 2/6/2019. First read in House and referred to House Health and Human Services 2/7/2019

**SDPhA Position:** Monitoring

**SB 137** This legislation provides for the payment of claims for covered services provided by a health care professional via telehealth

**Latest Action:** Passed as Amended, Senate 2/6/2019; First read in House and referred to House Commerce and Energy 2/7/2019

**SDPhA Position:** Monitoring

**HB 1111** This legislation provides for professional or occupational licensure for certain active duty military personnel and spouses

**Latest Action:** Passed as Amended, House of Representatives 2/11/2019, First read in Senate and Referred to Senate Military and Veterans Affairs 2/12/2019

**SDPhA Position:** Monitoring

**HB 1229** This legislation requires optional services through Medicaid to be authorized through special appropriation.

**Latest Action:** Passed as amended, House of Representatives 2/21/2019. First read in the Senate and referred to Appropriations 2/22/2019

**SDPhA Position: Opposed**

- As written, this legislation would mean any modification or change of pharmacy or other services in the state Medicaid plan would require a special appropriations bill and a 2/3 vote of the legislature.
- This bill will likely be on the House floor mid-week.

**HB 1137** This legislation revises certain provisions regarding pharmacy benefit managers.

**Latest Action:** Passed as Amended, Senate Health and Human Services. Placed on consent. 2/22/2019. SDPhA testified as a proponent.

**SDPhA Position: Support**

**HB 1049** This legislation revises certain provisions regarding driving after consuming certain drugs or substances.

**Latest Action:** Passed as Amended, Senate 2/19/2019

**SDPhA Position:** Monitoring

**HB 1060** This legislation makes an appropriation for increased reimbursement for care of residents of nursing facilities and assisted living facilities.

**Latest Action:** Scheduled for Hearing, Committee on Appropriations 2/25/2019

**SDPhA Position:** Monitoring
