South Dakota Pharmacists Commercial & Legislative (C&L) Branch Report (January 26, 2018)

[SB 32](#) This legislation places certain substances on the controlled substances schedule and to declare an emergency. *House Health and Human Services Do Pass, Passed 1/25/2018*

[SB 62](#) This legislation provides for the notification related to a breach of certain data and to provide a penalty therefor. *Monitoring – Senate Do Pass Amended, Passed 1/25/2018*

[SB 63](#) This Legislation revises certain prohibitions regarding methamphetamines and to create a mandatory penalty for a violation thereof. *Monitoring - Referred to Senate Judiciary 1/9/2018*

[SB 65](#) This legislation revises certain provisions regarding drug deliveries that result in death and to provide a penalty therefor. *Monitoring – Deferred by Chair, Senate Judiciary 1/9/2018*

[SB 75](#) This legislation establishes certain provisions regarding the dispensing of biological products. SDPhA Position: Neutral. *Senate Health and Human Services Do Pass, Passed. Placed on Consent Board of Pharmacy testified as a proponent. 1/22/2018; Scheduled for hearing, House Health and Human Services 1/30/2018*

[SB 141](#) This legislation establishes certain provisions regarding pharmacy benefits management. SDPhA Position: Support. *First read in Senate and referred to Senate Health and Human Services 1/24/2018*
